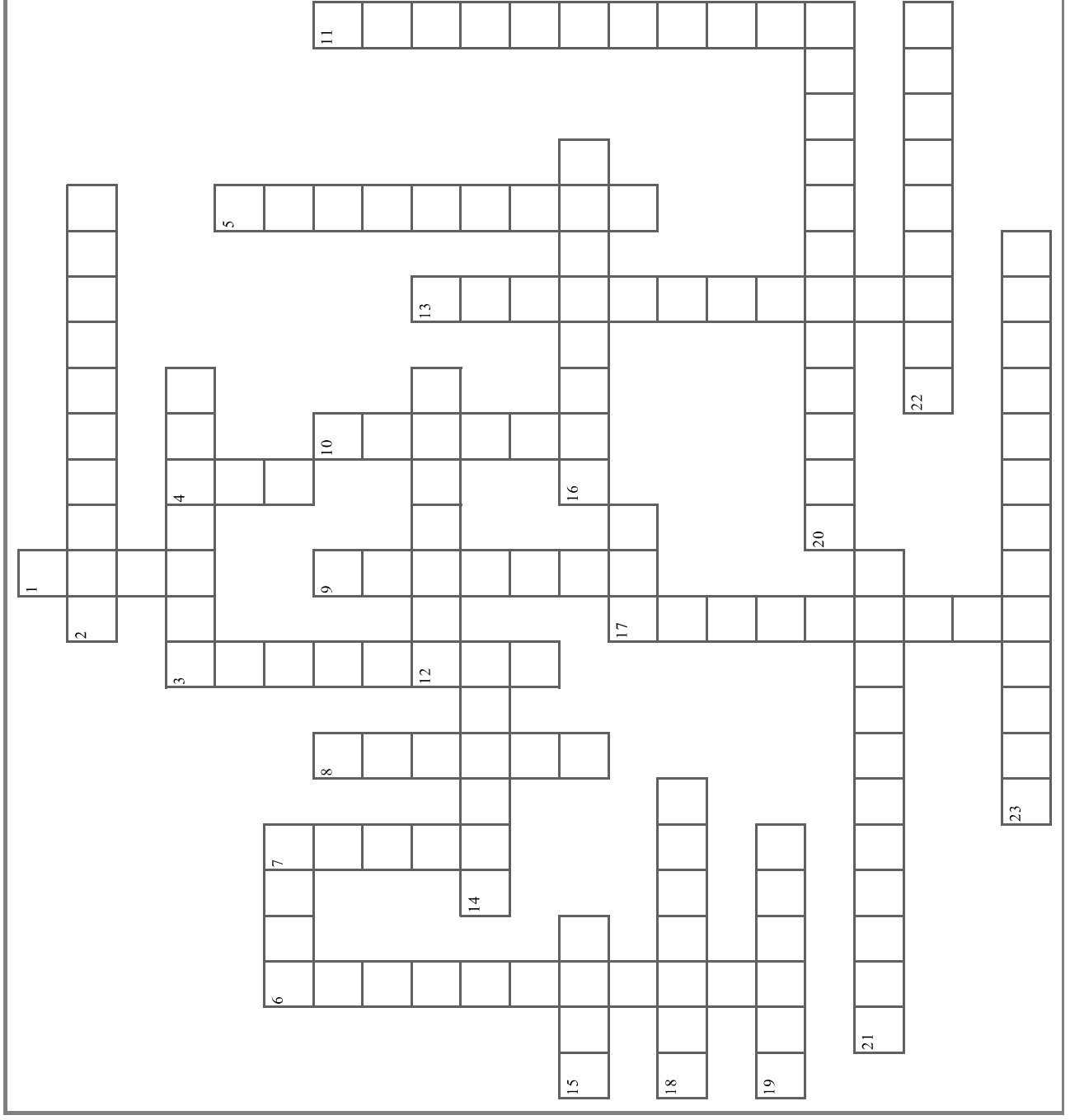


Kitchenware (1)



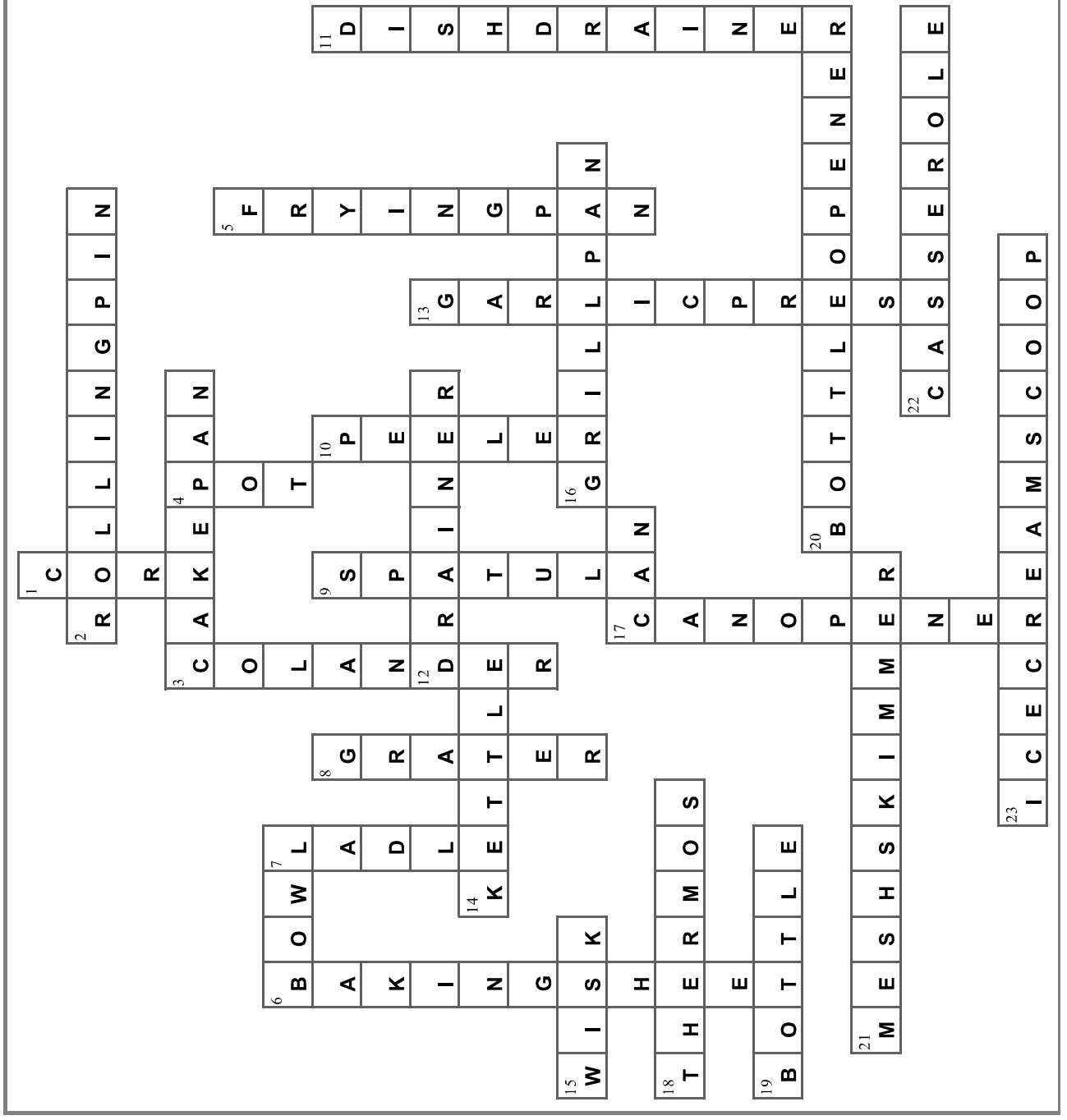
Across

2. A cylinder, sometimes with small handles at either end, used for rolling out and flattening dough, pastry, or other uncooked food. (10)
3. A cooking pot, usually metal and with a handle, for baking cakes in an oven. (7)
6. An open container, usually round in shape and wider than it is deep, typically used for holding food and liquids. (4)
12. A container in which things are put so that liquid can drain off them. (7)
14. A metal pot, that is used for boiling water. (6)
15. A kitchen utensil, formed of curved or coiled wires attached to a handle or a bundle of twigs or stalks, used to whip soft or liquid substances. (4)
16. A pan with a flat surface and a parallel metal bars pattern, on which food is grilled. (8)
17. A sealed metal container, usually cylindrical, in which food or drink is preserved or packaged and sold. (3)
18. A trademark for an insulated or vacuum container used to hold a liquid and maintain it at a constant temperature. (7)
19. A container for liquids, usually made of glass or plastic, with a narrow neck and no handle. (6)
20. A metal tool used to pry the metal tops off bottles. (12)
21. A broad flat spoon with small perforations in it, used to skim something such as fat from the surface of a liquid. (11)
22. A deep covered pot in which food can be cooked and served, that is usually used to cook a stew or other moist food. (9)
23. A utensil with a long handle and a small hemispherical bowl, used for serving such things as ice cream or making melon balls. (13)

Down

1. A usually cylindrical piece of material used as a bottle stopper. (4)
3. A bowl-shaped dish with holes in it. Use: draining food cooked in water and washing vegetables or fruit. (8)
4. A container made of metal, that is usually cylindrical and watertight with an open top and sometimes a lid, used especially for cooking. (3)
5. A shallow metal pan with a long handle, used for frying food. (9)
6. A flat metal tray used for baking cakes in an oven. (11)
7. A spoon with a long handle and a deep bowl, used to serve soup and other liquids. (5)
8. A device with many sharp-edged holes against which something such as cheese can be rubbed to reduce it to shreds or fine particles. (6)
9. A flat flexible metal, plastic, or rubber utensil with a handle, used to lift, spread, or mix. (7)
10. A device for removing the skin from fruit or vegetables, usually a hand-held utensil with a blade. (6)
11. A framework or stand for draining dishes (11)
13. A small kitchen tool, usually made of metal or plastic, that minces a clove of garlic by squeezing it through small holes. (11)
17. A device, either electric-powered or operated by hand, used for opening cans, especially cans of food. (9)

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
