


Meat mini pictictionary interactive crossword

6. The firm meaty flesh of the tuna, used as food. (4)
8. An individual pie filled with mincemeat and served hot or cold. (8)
10. The flesh of any edible fish eaten as food, either cooked or raw. (4)
13. The flesh of an animal that is considered edible, especially that of a mammal or bird. (4)
14. The lower half of the leg of a bird such as a chicken when prepared for eating, so called because of its shape. (9)
18. A crisp fried corn tortilla usually filled with meat, lettuce or cabbage, tomatoes, cheese, and hot sauce. (4)
19. A thick slice of beef from a lean part of a cow. (5)



1. Small cakes of cold boiled rice, shaped by hand or wrapped in seaweed and topped with pieces of raw or cooked fish, vegetables, or eggs. (5)
2. A tube of animal intestine or another tube-shaped casing stuffed with finely chopped pork or other meat. (7)
3. A hot dog on a stick, coated in cornmeal batter and deep-fried, typically sold at fairs and carnivals. (7)
5. The meat cut from the thigh of the hind leg of a hog after curing by salting or smoking. Cured hog flesh. (3)
7. Meat from a cow, heifer, bull, or steer. (4)
9. A flat patty of ground meat, usually beef, that is broiled, grilled, or fried and usually served in a bun. (9)
11. A long frankfurter usually served hot on a bread roll with toppings such as mustard, ketchup, or relish. (6)
12. The flesh of a hog eaten as food, usually cooked fresh. (4)
15. Fish and shellfish from the sea eaten as food. (7)
16. The meat from fowl. (7)
17. The flesh of a lobster used as food. (7)

18. The meat of the turkey used for food. (6)

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
